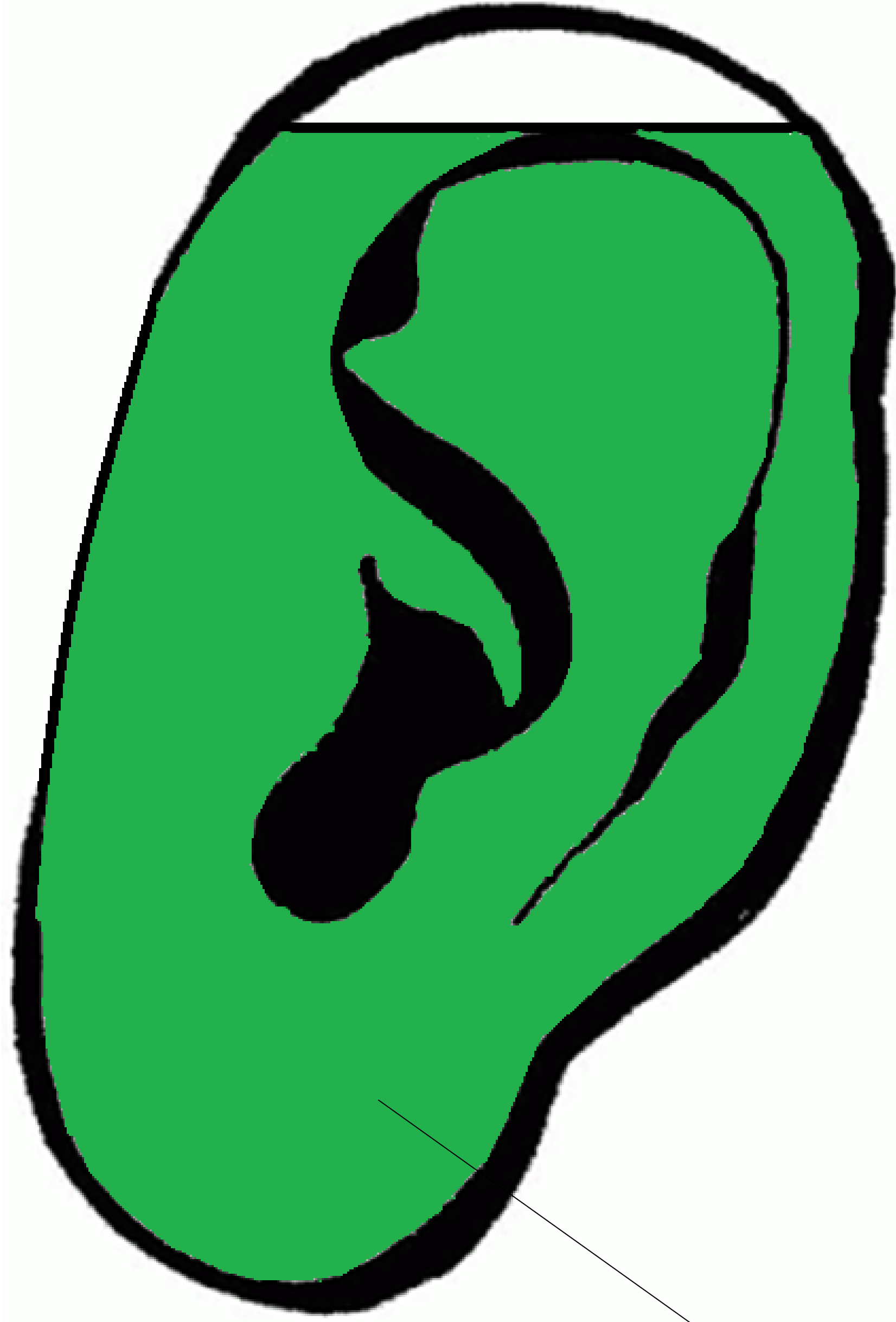


Gathering the Student's Voice

Data through the use of verbal surveys

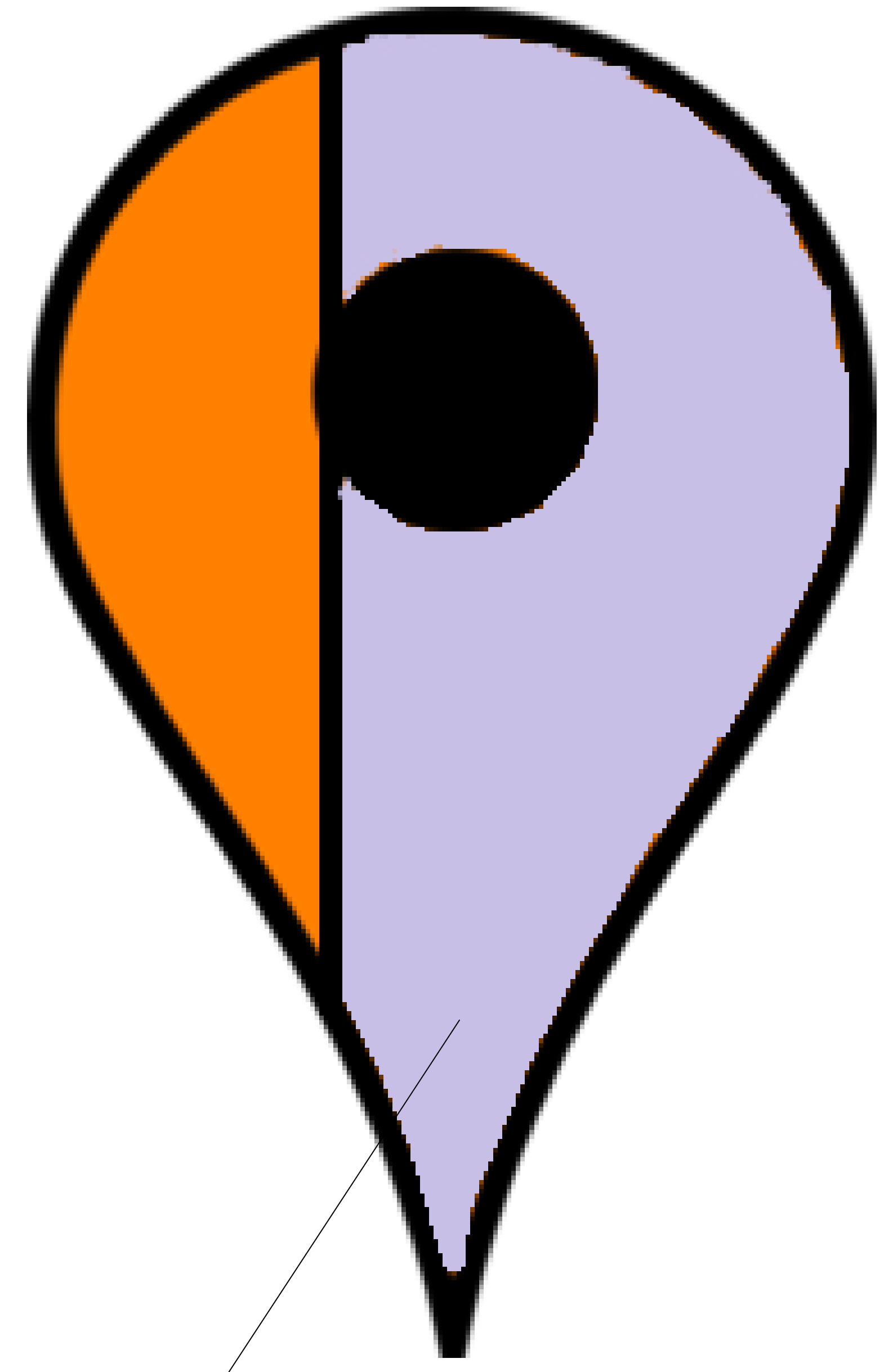
Results

In response to our question, "How many people have heard of Burnet Woods," 93% of people that we surveyed said that they had, in fact, heard of Burnet Woods, meaning about 7% of the people surveyed had not even heard of the park.



93% of people surveyed have heard of Burnet Woods

In response to our question, "How many people have been to Burnet Woods," 67% of people that we surveyed said that they had visited Burnet Woods at some point in their lives, with 33% never having visited it.



67% of people surveyed have visited Burnet Woods

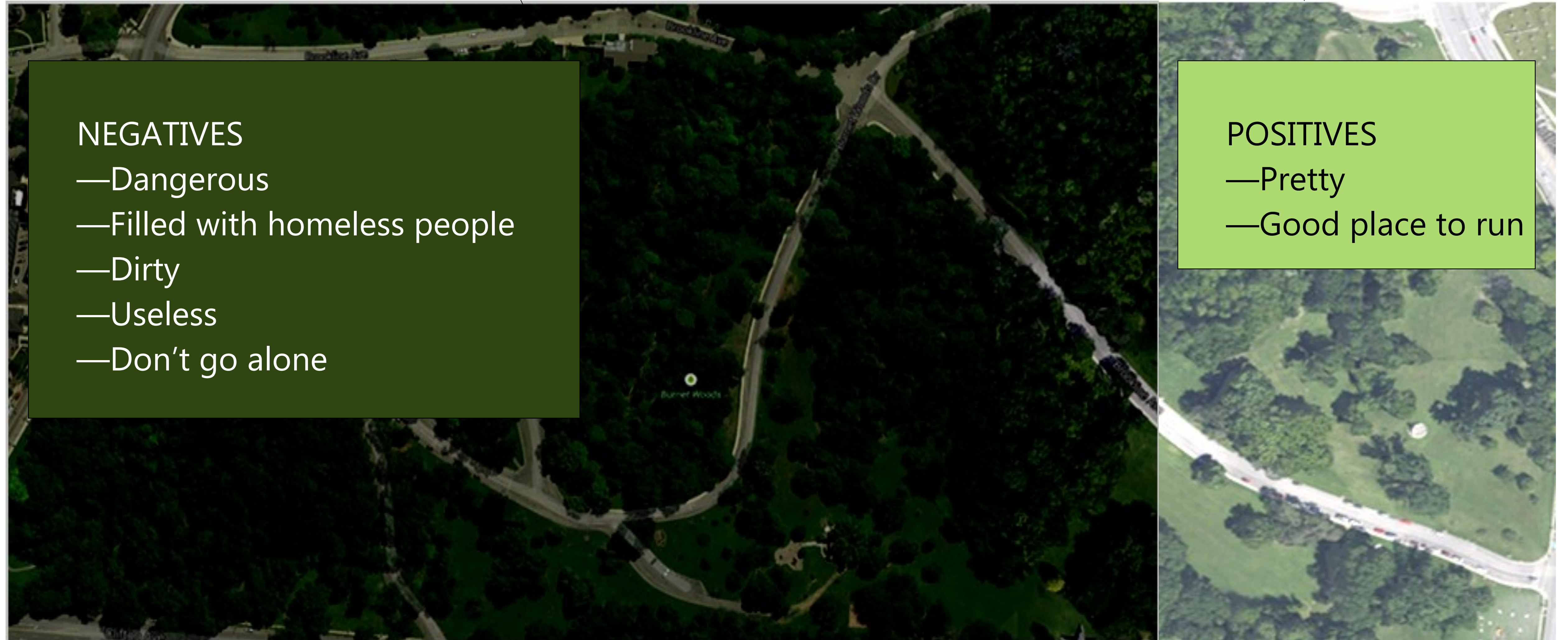
Response Questions

In response to our survey question, "What have you heard about Burnet Woods," namely including initial stereotypes or thoughts people had about Burnet Woods, we received an overwhelmingly negative response. Only two positives were ever stated by people whom we surveyed, while the majority of responses received were negative.

We also collected suggestions as to what students would change and add to Burnet Woods.

82% of responses were negative

18% of responses were positive
